RESERVE DEPUTIES

The Teller County Sheriff's Office Reserve Section is comprised of Colorado P.O.S.T. certified volunteers who augment the Operations and Detention Divisions of the Teller County Sheriff's Office. Each commissioned reserve may work alongside the agency's regular deputies or may work independently on special projects.

Each reserve deputy is provided one uniform (pant and shirt). They must purchase all other associated equipment.
